Dear Ms. McKittrick,

Our office has completed an initial review of the referendum petition submitted by the sponsors regarding Ordinance 2025-006. The deadline for submitting signatures was 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 25, 2025.

State law requires that the petition include at least 7,461 valid signatures in 75% of the Voter Participation Areas from registered voters in order to qualify for placement on the ballot. The sponsors submitted a total of 536 signatures, which is well short of the required threshold. Of those 536 signatures, 290 have been verified as valid, 34 have been rejected as invalid, and 212 signatures have not been reviewed. In the interest of best utilizing Utah County resources, we will not be proceeding with the signature verification review for the unreviewed signatures.

Thank you for your cooperation throughout this process. My staff and I appreciate your dedication and partnership in supporting the elections process in Orem.
