

What is Stalking?

The term **stalking** means engaging in a course of conduct directed at a specific person that would cause a reasonable person to fear for his or her safety or the safety of others or suffer substantial emotional distress.



What is Dating Violence?

Dating and relationship violence is a pattern of coercive and abusive tactics employed by one person in a relationship to gain power and control over another person. It can take many forms, including physical violence, coercion, threats, intimidation, isolation, and emotional, sexual or economic abuse.

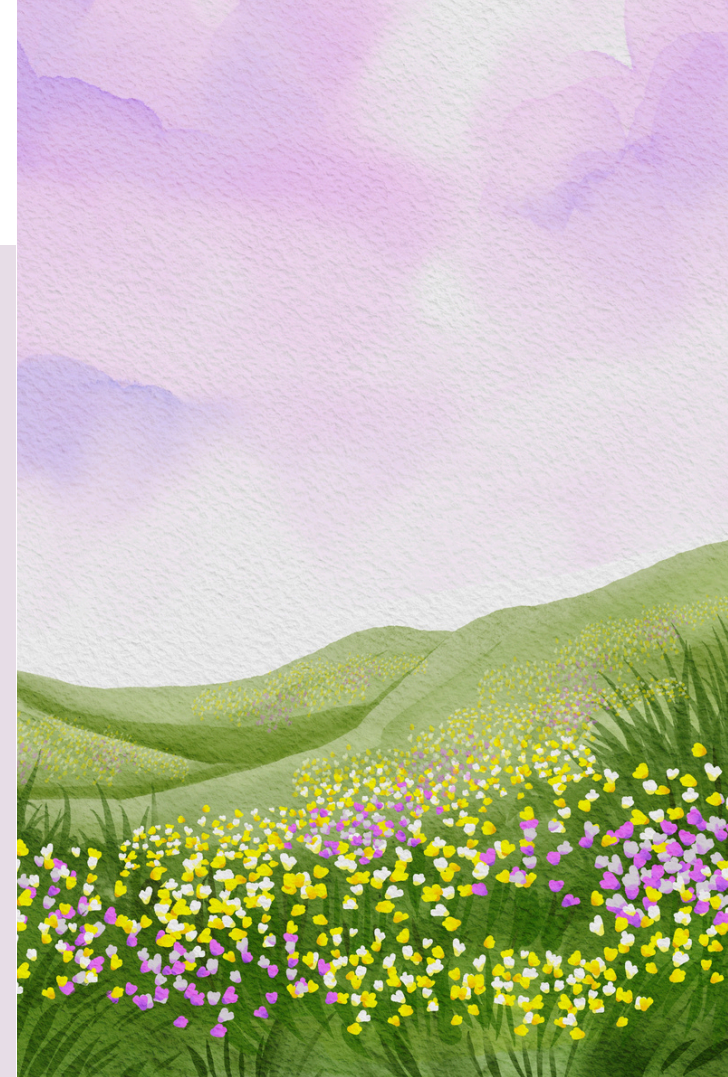

Stalking Injunctions

A civil stalking injunction is a court order that tells the respondent that they may not stalk the petitioner, may not contact or go near the petitioner, and may not go near others who are listed in the injunction.

A judge can grant an order that tells the respondent to stop stalking the petitioner if the respondent directly, or indirectly:

- followed
- monitored
- observed
- photographed
- surveilled
- threatened
- communicated to or about the petitioner
- interfered with the petitioner's property using any action, method, device, or means

Temporary Orders

If the court finds there is a good reason for granting the injunction, the court will issue a "ex parte" order.

The order tells the respondent that they have **10 days after being served in which to request a hearing if they want to dispute the order.** If the respondent requests a hearing, the court will notify the petitioner of the hearing date.

If the respondent does **not** request a hearing within 10 days of being served with the temporary civil stalking injunction, the temporary injunction automatically becomes a civil stalking injunction.

Duration of Order

- Order is in effect for three years from the date of service of the temporary injunction.
- The respondent will not receive additional notice that the temporary order has turned into a civil stalking injunction.
